Manipulating the Bible. The blue text below is exactly the same as the text on the next page in the blue picture. The Bible was compiled by the Catholic Bishops between 350 and 400 AD.

The finding is shocking. By placing headings and forming separate paragraphs, a completely different story is obtained. The prayer of prayers does not exist, for this story begins with a warning. When you pray, do it silently, in secret, in thought. So not openly and visible to everyone. But sincere!

God knows in advance what you want to pray, so one short sentence can be enough, as an example:

Our Father which art in heaven . hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven so on earth. Give us this day our daily bread, but not my will, but thine be done, Amen. Or even shorter: Dear Father, can you arrange food for us? Not my will, but yours be done, Amen.

' "When you pray, don't be like hypocrites. They love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the street corners so that people will see them. I assure you, that's the only reward they'll get. But when you pray, go to your room, shut the door, and pray to your Father who is present in that secret place. Your Father who sees what you do in secret will reward you. Don't be like them, because your Father knows what you need before you ask. Pray like this: Our Father who is in heaven, uphold the holiness of your name. Forgive us for the ways we have wronged you, just as we also forgive those who have wronged us. And don't lead us into temptation, but rescue us from the evil one. "If you forgive others their sins, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you don't forgive others, neither will your Father forgive your sins.

'Matthew wrote it as a whole. The Bible was compiled by Catholic Bishops at the end of the fourth century. After that, all kinds of scribes have tinkered with it and a text layout has been made, paragraphs have been formed, text headings have been placed, but the original text can be seen as one whole in blue above.

Short historical introduction

The Bishops lived far from each other and in completely different cultures. Over the centuries, the cultural background has made these "church leaders" think differently, interpret the scriptures differently, and their beliefs have also become very different from one another. It is similar to the difference between the Pharisees and the Sadducees, but even more diverse because more cultural backgrounds played a role.

It is with this difference of opinion that the Bible is composed. Due to a lack of time - great distances and pressure, pressure, pressure - there has been no possibility to come to a unity of faith. Nevertheless, there was a desire to collect the writings. Everything they disagreed on has been skipped. Major contentions included The Book of Enoch and the Book of Jasher. Also due to the lack of time, "loose" texts have been overlooked. So these are texts that are not understood by the whole of Christendom.

Some misunderstood texts can be found in: Matthew 27: 52 and 1 Peter 3:18 – 22

The building blocks of the Christian faith are completely undermined by the religions themselves. They think – and act accordingly – to be above the Most High. They change the rules at will. 1. The alleged prayer: The Our Father
2. The 10 Commandments

Why is this so important? Very simple: **God is the truth.**

By this I am not claiming that God is not the truth, but that every Christian religion is a lie.

I would like to briefly describe it.

The 10 Commandments

The first two commandments are about God himself. Thou shalt not worship idols. What does the RC do? It is literally bursting with idols.

But that's not a problem, then you just adjust the 10 commandments. Then it is no longer in there, so you no longer have to comply with it.

It's our father

In Matthew 6:5-15 there is a warning for the people who think they can be very prominent. Jesus says how to pray, but especially not like the Pharisees and the Sadducee (collectively: Scribes, Theologian isn't that the same as a Scribe?).

In the bible there is a very important text, it can be read in **1 Chronicles 28: 8** In summary: **Examine everything, even My will**
